Traffic on the school grounds

We draw your attention to our procedures regarding traffic on the school grounds. In the morning (8:00 - 9:00):

- 1. Cars may enter the school grounds and drop off the child/children only.
- 2. The only cars to park in the school grounds are staff cars.

Afternoon (3:00 - 3:30):

- 1. No car should enter the school grounds. Cones will be placed to stop cars. Nobody has the right to lift the cones. (Only the taxis can enter the school grounds at this time).
- 2. No car should park on the corners of the entrances:



If there is no space to park on the road a car park near the village hall is available.

We would be very grateful if you could pass this important information on to anyone dropping off your child in the morning or collecting your child from school in the afternoon. This is vital for the above to work.

We repeat this message again - for the safety of our children.
